## Terms and Conditions

1. Please send a copy of your public liability insurance certificate. Failure to supply this will result in automatic rejection. Only send copies of your certificate as these will not be returned.
2. If you are selling **any** food products, your food hygiene certificate must be displayed at all times and take appropriate measures to maintain high levels of hygiene at all times. Daventry Council may spot check the site, failure to comply may result in being removed off site.
3. Products and/or services sold must be as described, a full price list must be displayed at all times.
4. Your pitch must be set up no later by 09:00 of the morning of each day. Any vehicles that are a. not part of the stall or b. supporting the stall, must be removed off site and moved into the public car park.
5. Re-entry to site will commence at 16:30. No movement on site until 16.30, unless exceptional circumstances with prior agreement from the event organiser(s).
6. Marston Steam & Vintage Show Limited (and those affiliated with the show) do not take any responsibility for damage, loss, theft of products equipment and/or services.
7. Marston Steam & Vintage Show take no responsibility for any loss of earnings. We cannot guarantee the weather or numbers of the public attending.
8. Application fees are non-refundable unless in exceptional circumstances.
9. Fair play/fair trading; you must clearly state what you are selling, if you are found selling items other than what is clearly stated on your application form, then you will be asked to remove these items from sale. Refusal can lead to eviction off site.
10. Sales of restricted goods such as guns, weapons, narcotics, and knives etc. are **strictly** prohibited. Found doing so may result in reporting to the police.

13. All food/general waste must be placed in the skips provided
14. **Electrical power will not be provided.** Electrical equipment must be safe to use and Pat tested where appropriate. Generators must comply to current noise and environmental regulations.
15. If you are applying as a standalone coffee unit. You will likely be placed in a different location amongst stalls. You **must** use a super silenced generator. Do not apply if you cannot conform to this rule.
